# **Rhode Island**

#### **KEY FACTS**

- Official state name: Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
- **Population:** 1 million (<u>2017 estimate</u>) 8<sup>th</sup> least populous state
- Major Cities: Providence (2016)
- Gross Domestic Product (GDP): In <u>2016</u>, Rhode Island GDP was \$57.5 billion and ranked 44<sup>th</sup> in the United States.
- GDP Growth: In 2016, Rhode Island real GDP grew 0.5 per cent; the 2015-16 national change was 1.5 per cent.
- **Key Industries:** In <u>2016</u>, the largest industry in Rhode Island was finance, insurance, real estate, rental and leasing. This industry accounted for 24.9 per cent of Rhode Island GDP and had a 0.1 per cent real growth.
- Known for: Being the smallest state in size in the United States (1,214 square miles), being the first of the original 13 colonies to renounce its allegiance to the British crown but the last to become a state, home to the Tennis Hall of Fame, making silverware and jewellery, boating, Rhode Island Reds (a breed of chicken), the birthplace of polo, coffee milk.

Exports from Rhode Island to Australia increased 27 per cent between the signing of the AUSFTA in 2005 and 2013.

# THE SEARCH FOR THE HMS ENDEAVOUR

In 2016, it was announced that historic documents showed that Captain Cook's *HMS Endeavour* (renamed the *Lord Sandwich*) was scuttled in Newport Harbour in 1778 by the British navy in order to blockade a channel during the American Revolution.

US archaeologists from the Rhode Island Marine Archaeology Project (RIMAP), together with marine researchers from the Australian National Maritime Museum (ANMM) in Sydney, are excavating and mapping a number of the wreckages in Newport Harbour in an attempt to confirm which wreckage is the *Lord Sandwich ex Endeavour*.

Work on the project has been slow as it is conducted by volunteers with limited financial support. As of early 2018, further excavations have been delayed until RIMAP can develop an artefact management and storage facility.

The relationship between RIMAP and the ANMM was formalised in 2014 when the Director of the ANMM, Kevin Sumption, and Dr Kathy Abbass from RIMAP signed a Memorandum of Understanding at the Australian Embassy. Former Australian Ambassador to the US Kim Beazley witnessed the signing.

#### **MAJOR EVENTS**

- Newport Winter Festival: New England's largest winter extravaganza – food, music and entertainment.
- Newport Jazz Festival: the first ever jazz festival in the United States and one of the most popular in the country.
- Newport Folk Festival: annual folk festival held at the end of July at Fort Adams. Aussie Courtney Barnett is on the 2018 line-up.
